- The title you would like associated with the job or internship. Please keep to fewer than 10 words.
- A brief description of the job(s) or internship(s). This can include information such as the job title, who would be qualified, compensation, a brief description of duties, etc but please limit these to 3 or 4 sentences.
- A pdf of the full job description, or an external link to the full job description/application, or an email address to contact for more information. Unfortunately we cannot host full descriptions unless it is in a pdf format.
- Any other special instructions. Typically postings are left on the site for approximately 30-45 days, unless otherwise specified.
